#### ***The Earliest Work of True Scientific Research To Emerge From The Gold Rush***

Nice example of this important regional map of Northern California covering the recently discovered Gold Regions of California, from Philip Thomas Tyson's *Geology and Topography of California*.

Tyson visited the Gold regions in the summer and fall of 1849. Carl Wheat notes that Tyson's work was "probably the earliest work of a true scientific research to emerge from the Gold Rush. Its author was a gifted scientist whose pioneering effort was of considerable value."
