Description:

Striking example of Coronelli's spectacular 2 sheet map of Ireland.

Coronelli's map of Ireland, appeared in his *Atlante Veneto* and his *Corso Geographico*. The map is cartographically similar to the details present in Coronelli's famous globe of 1688 and richly embellished with a style unique to Coronelli's maps.

Vincenzo Maria Coronelli, a Venetian scholar and Minorite Friar, was one of the most celebrated map and globe makers of his era. Cornelli produced more than one hundred terrestrial and celestial globes, several hundred maps, and a wealth of cartographic publications. In 1683, he completed the Marly Globes for



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Louis XIV, the largest and most magnificent globes ever made. In 1684 he founded the *Accademia Cosmografica degli Argonauti*, the first geographical society, and was appointed Cosmographer of the Republic of Venice.
