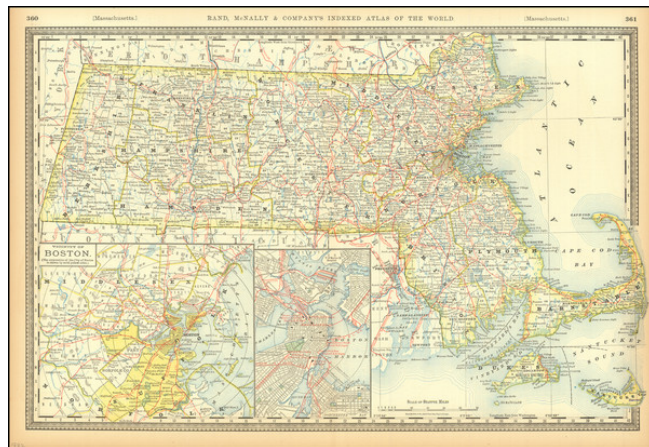

Detailed antique map of Massachusetts, showing cities, towns, rivers, and railways.

Three Shaker villages are mapped: southwest of Pittsfield at G3 (Hancock), due east of Leominster (Shirley) at E23, and just north of Harvard Station at D23 (Harvard). There is also a town named Podunk, just southwest of Brookfield. The short-lived Martha's Vineyard Railroad, operating from 1874 to 1896, is shown, connecting Oak Bluffs to Katama and South Beach. The Boston Farm School is shown on Thompson's Island on the Boston inset map, as is Harvard University in Cambridge.
