



Fanciful view of the Roman city of Tiburtina, from the *Liber Chronicum* "Nuremberg Chronicle," a landmark work of the 15th century.

The map shows the city of Lazio, formerly known as Tibur during the Roman era. Lying 20 miles northeast of Rome, it was formerly connected to the capital via the Via Tiburtina, which was extended as the Via Valeria to cross the Apennines. Tibur was defeated and conquered by the Romans in 338 BC.

The text above the map describes the history of Tibur, including its mentions in the works of Virgil and Strabo. The geography is also described.
