

## **Description:**

Vancouver's view of a Valparaiso, Chile, visited by the Vancouver Expedition on its return home from the Pacific in 1795.

Although instructed to avoid Spanish possessions in the Pacific, Vancouver's expediton was required some refitting and had been ordered to survey as much of the coast as possible. Vancouver therefore put into Valparaiso in the Viceroyalty of Peru on March 25, 1795 for five weeks of repairs with the help of the Spanish. The expedition's officers enjoyed an official visit to the Capitan General and Royal Governor of Chile, Don Ambrosio O'Higgins de Vallenar, at the capital Santiago.
