



Fine original antique map showing south-central Russia near Lake Chany, on the Kazak border. This map was published by Philippe Vandermaelen in Brussels.

The map shows is centered on part of the Novosibirsk Oblast and the map shows a variety of features, including roads, mountains, lakes, rivers, ruins, and more. This would have been one of the most detailed maps of the region at the time.

This map first appeared in Vandermaelen's remarkable 6-volume atlas of the world. The atlas is composed of sheets covering the entire known world at the time, which, if combined as globe gores, form an immense globe. As such, Vandermaelen accomplished the first atlas mapping of the world on a uniform scale.
