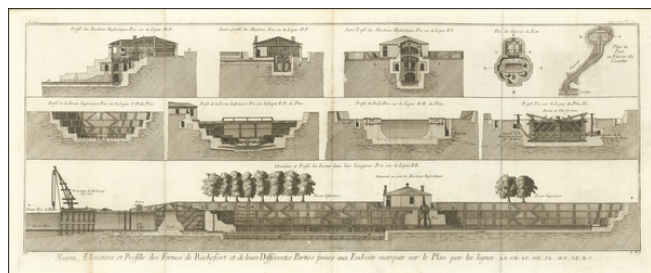

**Description:**

Impressive cross-sections of the locks and related machinery used at Rochefort by the French Navy to build naval vessels, including some that would soon fight in the American Revolution.

The engraving shows some nine different plans that display the workings of individual locks, through cross-sections and . Plans of the workings, including the pumps and machine houses, are shown.

This plan was designed by the main engraver for the French Navy at this time, Nicolas Bellin, and published in Diderot's monumental *Encyclopedie*.
