

Fine original antique map showing northern Russia just east of Novaya Zembla, along the Gulf of Obskaia. This map was published by Philippe Vandermaelen in Brussels.

The map shows the arctic coastline of Russia with a variety of features, including roads, mountains, lakes, rivers, ruins, and more. This would have been one of the most detailed maps of the region at the time.

This map first appeared in Vandermaelen's remarkable 6-volume atlas of the world. The atlas is composed of sheets covering the entire known world at the time, which, if combined as globe gores, form an immense globe. As such, Vandermaelen accomplished the first atlas mapping of the world on a uniform scale.
