Extends south to include Shirley Fort and Ft. Dummer. Includes the St. Croix and St. Johns Rivers, which would become the source of the boundary disputes between the British Possessions and the newly formed US in the coming decades. Numerous other forts, shown, including Ft. Western, Ft. Richomont, Frank Fort, Georges Ft., Ft. Halifax, Ft. Richliu, Ft. Sorel, St. John's Ft., Chambly Ft., Crown Point, etc.

Extends to Montreal and the St. Lawrence. From the March issue of the *Universal Magazine*.
