



Description:

Beautifully colored Scottish map of the world from the early part of the 19th century.

This map shows a beautiful rendition of the globe, with a focus on physical geography. Some political boundaries are also shown. The map is colored according to continents. Small insets in the corners show the spherical properties of the globe, including the distributions of temperature according to latitude. No southern continent is shown, and Arctic discoveries are still somewhat limited. Mythological features, such as the Mountains of the Moon in Africa, persist.

This map was published as part of Ewing's *General Atlas* by Oliver and Boyd, and engraved by W. & D. Lizards.
