Detailed map of South America, published by JH Colton.

The map is hand colored by countries and provides an excellent snapshot of South America immediately after its Revolutionary Period, with Spain and Portugal now largely expelled from the Continent.

Shows towns, rivers, mountains, lakes, etc. Many regions are still not well explored. Each of the modern countries is now named, except for Columbia, which is New Granada. Patagonia is still separately named.

From the scarce 1859 edition of Colton's atlas, which is the first to include the imprint of Johnson & Browning, one year before these two publishers created their own *New Illustrated Family Atlas of the World*.
