### Description:

Beautifully colored Scottish map of North America from the early part of the 19th century.

This map shows the continent in detail, with political boundaries colored and geographical data shown throughout. The United States is bounded to the west by the Mississippi. Native American tribes are named, including the "Dog ribbed Indians," the "Doeg Inds," and the "Hare Indians."

Though it was made long after the Louisiana Purchase, the fact of American westward expansion seems to have barely registered with the mapmaker.

This map was published as part of Ewing's *General Atlas* by Oliver and Boyd, and engraved by W. & D. Lizards.
