Nice example of the Hondius-Jansson Map of North America, first published in 1618. Includes a marvelous peninsular California with the NW Coast of America stretch almost due westward toward Asia, with over 30 place names. Includes an unusual East Coast of North America, packed full of placenames, including Chesdpiooc (Chesapeake), Sanawanook, Hatoraske (Hatteras); Charlefort, Cap de S. Roman, etc. No Great Lakes are shown, nor does Long Island appear. Oversized South America, with Indians and Animal vignettes in the interior. The Rio Grande flows into the Gulf of California. The 7 cities of Cibola appear on a lake, which is the apparent source of the Rio Grande. Includes Sailing Ships, Sea Monsters and other decorations. A nice wide margined example in old color, from a French edition of Jansson's Atlas, not recorded by Burden. A bit of soiling in the margins. Burden 192, State 5.
