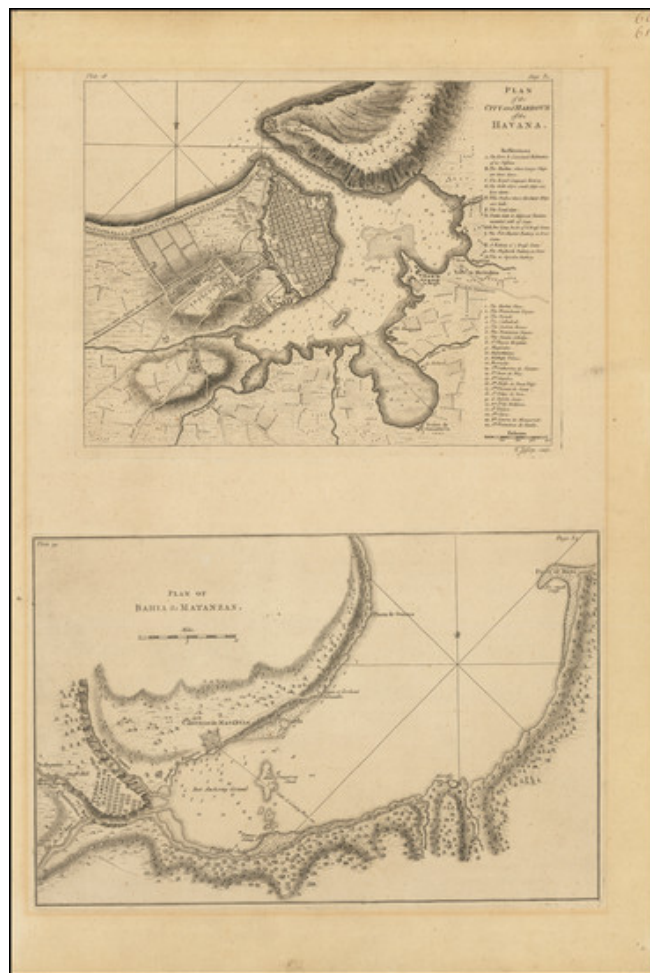

Description:

Two scarce engraved maps of Cuban harbors (Havana and Matanzas) on one sheet, prepared as such for Thomas Jeffreys's much sought-after *A General Topography of North America*.

The engravings initially appeared in Jeffreys's 1762 *A Description of the Spanish Islands and Settlements on the Coast of the West Indies*, hence the plate and page numbers.

Both of the maps are very well rendered and detailed. These ports were of particular interest to the Royal Navy during the middle of the 18th century.

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Jeffery's *A General Topography* is not only one of the most important atlases of the 18th century but also one of the rarest. It is particularly notable for its extensive depictions of many major and minor American settlements, as well as a detailed treatment of the frontier regions.
