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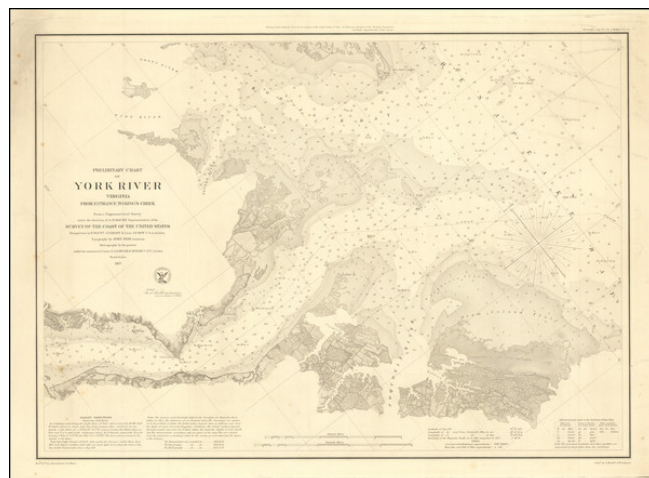

Detailed Coast Survey Chart showing a section of the entrance to the York River from Cheasapeake Bay.

The maps are exceptionally detailed, including sailing directions, soundings and other fine details.

The first of the charts listed below (*Entrance to King's Creek*) was also issued as part of the Annual Report of the Coast Survey. A second chart (*King's Creek To West Point*) was only issued separately and did not appear in an Annual Report and is now quite rare. We located only the copies in the Virginia State Library, Huntington Library and NOAA.
