Rare map of America, showing California as an Island, published by Monath in Nuremberg.

Includes an unusual set of Great Lakes (including Lake "Supper" and Lake "Illions").

The course of the Mississippi is unusually far to the west of its normal course, teasing a prospective short portage from its western source to the Pacific Ocean.

Several unusual place names, including Vacqueros in upper New Mexico and "Orleans" on the Mississippi River, not far from where one one expect to find Minneapolis.

Charleston is "Carlestown".
