

Rand McNally map of New Mexico, detailing counties, cities, rivers, mountains, railroads, mining districts, and reservations.

The county seat in Colfax County is Springer, having been moved from Cimarron in 1881, and was the site of one of the last major shoot-outs of the Colfax County War in 1885. The county seat was moved to Raton in 1897. In Socorro County, Lake Valley, a former silver-mining town and now a ghost town, is present in Lake Valley District (mining district #51) in Sierra County.

The Denver and Rio Grande Railroad stops at Trinidad, Colorado, having ceded access through the Raton Pass to the Santa Fe Railroad during the Royal Gorge Railroad War of the late 1870s.
