

This map is likely a prototype for a map which James intended to accompany his 1906 book, *The Wonders of the Colorado Desert*.

James' map shows the main routes which he took through the Southern California region. he map shows roads, trails, waterways, winter streams, areas of heavy sand, and differentiates lakes and reservoirs that are constant from those which exist only a part of the year.
