### **Description:**

Interesting piece of pictorial mapmaking history, being the cut-sheet produced for Richard E. Bishop's highly regarding *Map of the Surface-Feeding Ducks, Swans, and Geese of North America*.

The cut-sheet shows a reduced version of the completed map, as well as an inset for the description of the Common Mallard, showing the male, female, and the specie's North American range. It also includes a description of the map and the surp price for cloth lacquered (\$15.00) and mounted (\$17.50) examples.

Richard E. Bishop was an American illustrator and visual artist focusing on depictions of ducks and geese. Bishop would rise to fame when he won the national duck stamp competition in 1936, the third year of the competition. In 1937, he produced a map similar to the *Surface-Feeding Ducks* entitled <u>Map of the</u> <u>Diving Ducks</u>, <u>Eiders</u>, <u>and Mergansers of North America</u>.
