While the map is relatively simple in its construction, it provides a detailed overview of the railroads and canals in 1835, one of the earliest general maps of the United States to focus on transportation routes.

By the time of its printing, very few railroad lines had been completed, but the map shows prospective lines extending from Charleston and Augusta to Memphis on the Mississippi River and from the east coast to Lake Michigan.
