Highly detailed map of California, with insets of the Los Angeles Basin (including Orange County) and part of San Diego and San Bernardino Counties, and a larger inset of the Bay Area.

Ladrillo, north of Pacific Beach, likely refers to Ladrillo Station, after the Spanish word for "brick", in Rose Canyon, and where the Rose Canyon Brick Company operated. The rail station at "Tia Juana", in the present-day location of San Ysidro, California, was a subdivision called "Tia Juana City", developed in 1887 by the real estate firm Hart and Stern, around the same that Tijuana was being developed across the border in Mexico.

Shows towns, roads, rivers, lakes, mining areas, mountains, Indian reservations, islands and a host of other details. A striking large format map.
