Detailed note in the lower right corner notes that this map was perhaps the earliest map to describe the postal routes in the colonies, including delivery schedules to Burlington, Perth Amboy, New York, Philadelphia, Boston, New London, Sommington, Bristol, Piscataway, Ipswich, Salem, Marblehead, and Newberry, even noting the days of the week and times of arrival.
