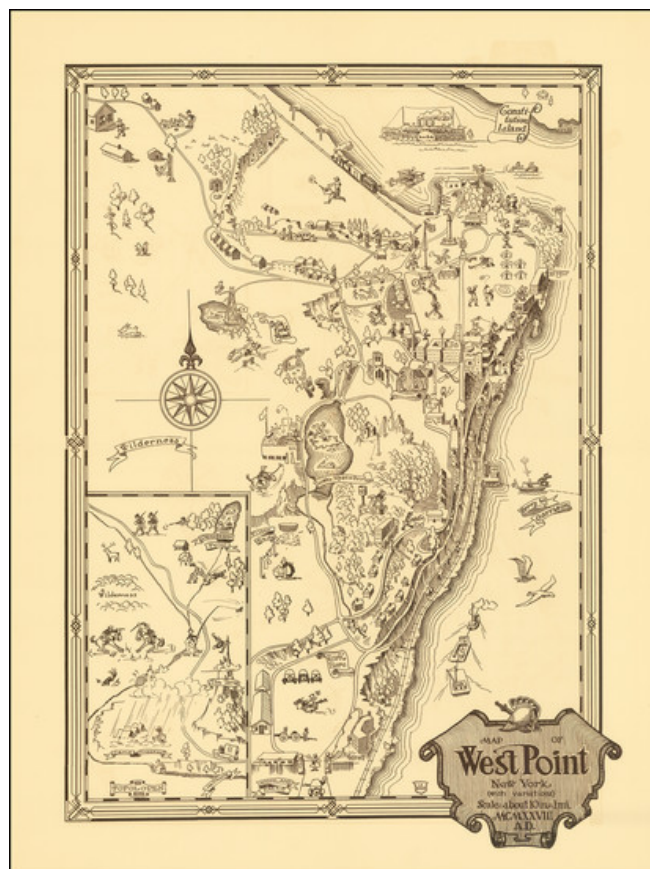

***Pictorial Map of West Point by A Distinguished Alumnus and Professor***

Rare black and white example of this rare pictorial map of West Point, drawn by L.E. Schick in 1928.

L.E. Schick is almost certain Brigadier General Lawrence Schick (1897-1967), West Point Class of 1920 and began his career as a Cavalry Officer.

After World War II, Schick was a professor of Military Topography and Graphics at West Point from 1946 to 1965. His drawing of Washington Hall in 1960 was produced by the West Point Fund Committee as a keepsake.

Schick participated in the negotiations of the surrender of the Japanese in 1945.
