Towns are shown, including Auburn, Newcastle, Roseville, Antelope, and Lincoln. Adjacent counties, including Sacramento, El Dorado, Nevada, Sutter, and Yuba are named.

This map was issued by the State Mining Bureau of California in c. 1902. Placer County is, of course, one of the historic centers of mining for California where gold was discovered in 1848.
