This evocative photograph, AS14-66-9293, taken on February 5, 1971, presents a portion of the Fra Mauro landing site as seen through the lens of one of the Apollo 14 astronauts. Captured during the early minutes of their first extravehicular activity (EVA) on the moon, the astronaut stood slightly southwest of the Lunar Module (LM) to take this image. At the lower left corner, the shadow of the astronaut taking the picture is clearly visible. This photograph is part of a series of images numbered AS14-66-9271 through AS14-66-9293 that together create a comprehensive 360-degree panoramic view of the lunar landscape experienced during the Apollo 14 mission.
