Description:

This photograph presents a mirrored depiction of the northeast view of Astronaut Edgar D. Mitchell, the Lunar Module pilot for Apollo 14, interacting with a TV camera. Captured during the first Extra-Vehicular Activity (EVA) of the Apollo 14 mission, the image showcases Mitchell's focused engagement with the camera equipment. The original film magazine was labeled II, utilizing S0168 film type (High-Speed Color Reversal, Interior/Surface) and a 60mm lens. The sun's elevation at the time of the photograph was 12 degrees, casting a distinct illumination on the lunar surface. There is a nebula or other luminous celestial body above the horizon.
