

Rich full color example, from the first edition of Carey & Lea's Atlas. Many counties still not formed. Size includes text below map, which includes wonderful contemporary details concerning the topography, indigenous lands, rivers, climate, towns, manufacturing, commerce, education, history, population by county (divided into white, free colored, and slaves), Indian Country and other information. Large NW corner is Cherokkee Lands, with Lower Creek lands below. Huge Early, Irwin and Appling Counties shown. Below are East and West Florida. An excellent early map of Georgia. Minor fold splits top and bottom, but still and excellent example. Carey & Lea's Atlas is highly prized not only for its cartographic information but the marvelous information about each of the states and territories which is included. The atlas was issued in 6 editions in English, French & German between 1822 and 1827.
