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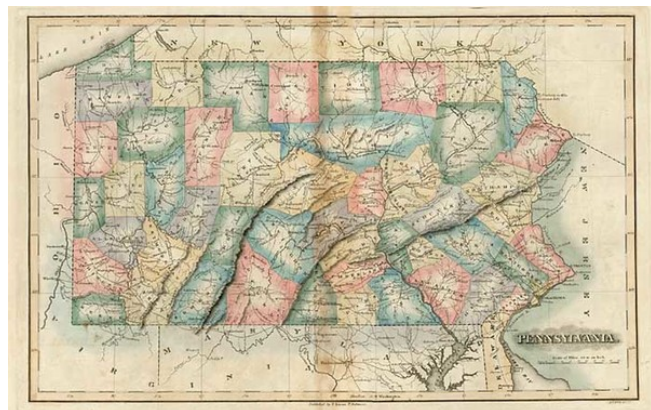

A wide margined example of one of the scarcest and most attractive maps of Pennsylvania to appear in an American Atlas.

PA has 51 counties, with Lycoming and Luzerne much reduced but still oversized and Blair, Cameron, Carbon, Clarion, Clinton, Elk, Forest, Juniata, Lackawanna, Lawrence, Monroe, Montour, Sullivan, Snyder and Wyoming still missing. The State Road from Kittanning to Hamilton NY and the National Road (which starts in Baltimore) shown. This is perhaps the rarest and most attractive of all early 19th Century atlas maps of Pennsylvania. Very attractive outline coloring. Light browning at centerfold but still a good example of this scarce map from Lucas' General Atlas
