Description:

Scarce map showing most of Manhattan Island, along with the neighboring cities, islands, etc. Extends to about 130th, Harlem, Mount Morris and the Lunatic Asylum. Includes a nice street plan of Brooklyn, Williamsburg and Jersey City. Names streets and numbering the wards. Many squares and places shown, including Union Place, Tompkins Square, Washington Square, Gramercy Park, Hudson Square, Bowling Green, Battery, etc. A large Lumber Basin is shown in the East River. Ferry routes shown. One of the few maps to extend so far north on the Island. A bit foxed, else a good example.
