Size includes text below map, which includes wonderful contemporary details concerning the topography, indigenous lands, rivers, climate, towns, manufacturing, commerce, education, history, population by county, and other information. Roads, towns, rivers, and forts included on map. Flags indicate seven "places remarkable for battles and sieges". Boundary dispute between Ohio and Michigan shown. Carey & Lea's Atlas is highly prized not only for its cartographic information but the marvelous information about each of the states and territories included. The atlas was issued in 6 editions in English, French & German between 1822 and 1827. Repaired fold split and a bit of marginal chipping, not affecting image and one thin spot in Lake Erie, with a small repaired tear. Normally a \$495.00 map.
