

Description:

Gorgeous example of the first edition of this scarce early map of Wisconsin, issued 10 years after it first became a territory. The lands south of the Wisconsin and Fox Rivers are largely surveyed and many early counties, towns, etc. appear. The region to the north is dominated by St. Croix and Crawford Counties, previously the lands of the Winnebagos, Menomonies, Oneidas, Sioux and Chippewa. Massive Carver claim remains, now nearly 100 years old. The south is filled with roads, and towns, the north rivers, portages, etc. One of the best early maps of Wisconsin in full original color. A bit toned, but still a good example.
